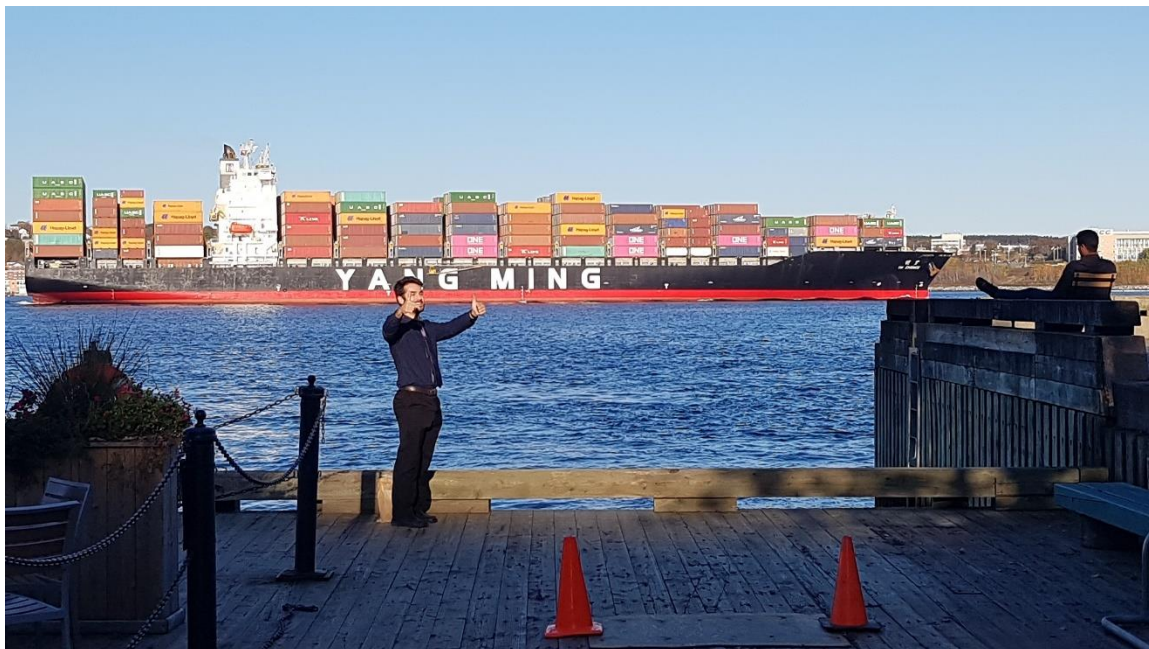


Figure 2: Found out what they carry the grease pole on
